UPDATE: Drinking water advisory continues for part of the Town of Arnprior

Pembroke — The drinking water advisory that has been issued as a precautionary measure to **all users of the Municipal Water System in the Town of Arnprior** remains in effect today for certain areas in Arnprior. See www.arnprior.ca for information on affected areas.

If you are located within the specified affected area, **FOR YOUR PROTECTION AND UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, DO NOT USE THIS WATER FOR:**

- drinking,
- food preparation,
- cooking,
- making ice,
- washing dishes,
- brushing teeth,
- preparing infant formula,
- hand washing, bathing or showering.

This water should only be used for flushing toilets and laundering clothes.

COMMERCIAL BOTTLED WATER SHOULD BE USED FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

BOTTLED WATER IS AVAILABLE FOR AFFECTED RESIDENTS AT THE NICK SMITH CENTRE LOCATED AT 77 JAMES STREET IN ANRPRIOR.

This advisory will be in effect until Renfrew County and District Health Unit is assured through adequate testing that a potential health hazard has been eliminated.
