

RCD COVID-19 Vaccine Rollout at a Glance

Update: March 17, 2021



Key Messages

1. An online vaccine booking system has been set up for RCD! Individuals that are currently eligible for vaccination can visit www.rcdhu.com or ontario.ca/bookvaccine to register. If you can't access the online system, please ask a family member or friend to assist you.

2. If you can't register online, please call RCDHU at 613-735-9724 or 1-800-267-1097 extension 200. The phone lines will be answered 7 days/week, from 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. **Please leave your name and number, and only leave one voice message.**

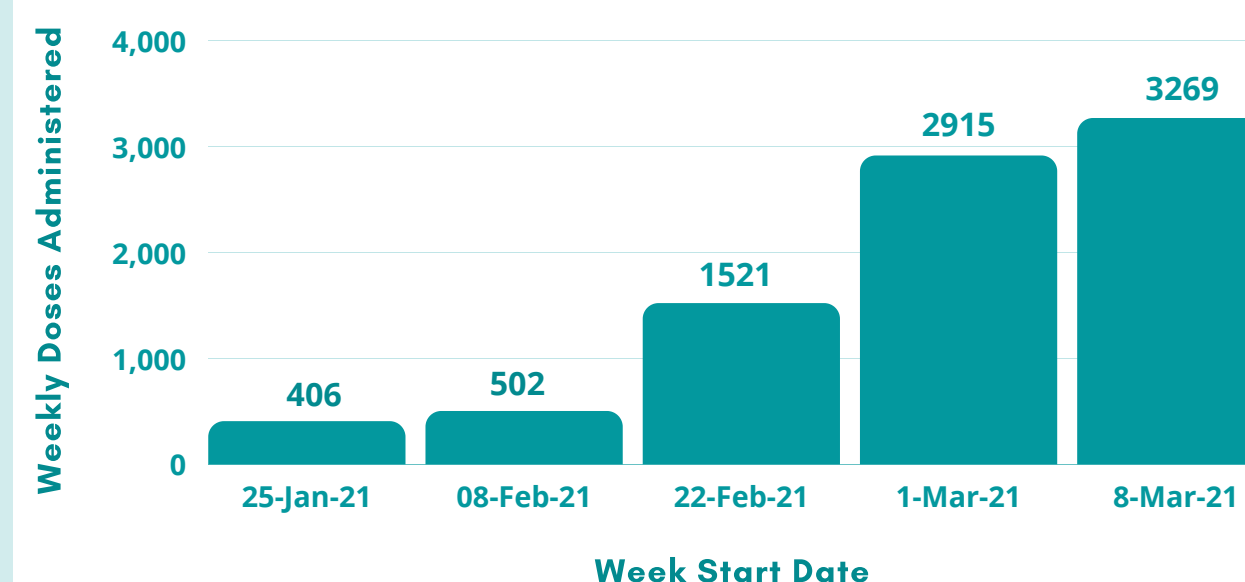
3. Availability of vaccination appointments will be based on the number of vaccine doses that RCD receives each week. Because of this, people should anticipate that it will take a number of weeks for everyone in the new groupings to be able to book and receive their vaccinations.
