

COVID-19 VACCINE CLINIC SCHEDULE

Renfrew County and District (RCD) September 04 - September 17, 2022



Anyone 5 years of age and older can [visit a pharmacy to get their COVID-19 vaccine](#), **subject to vaccine availability**. Be sure to **call the pharmacy ahead of time** if you plan to get vaccinated there, as vaccine supply varies and appointments may be required.



First or second doses: Anyone 6 months of age or older (wait at least eight weeks between doses).



First booster dose: Residents 12 years of age or older can receive their first booster dose at a minimum of **three months (84 days)** after their second dose (on or before **June 19, 2022**).

***NEW Children 5-11 years of age can receive their first booster dose** at a minimum of three months (**84 days**) after their second dose (on or before **June 19, 2022**).



Second booster dose: Anyone 18 years of age and older (**strongly recommended for those at greater risk of experiencing severe outcomes due to COVID-19 infection**) can receive a second booster dose at a minimum of **three months (84 days)** with informed consent after their first booster dose (on or before **Jun 19, 2022**).
