ED Visits for Influenza-Like-Illness (ILI) and Respiratory Concerns	Visits for Influenza-Like Illness and respiratory concerns accounted for 9.9% of ED visits in Week 16 compared to 11.5% in Week 15 (source ACES)	Similar

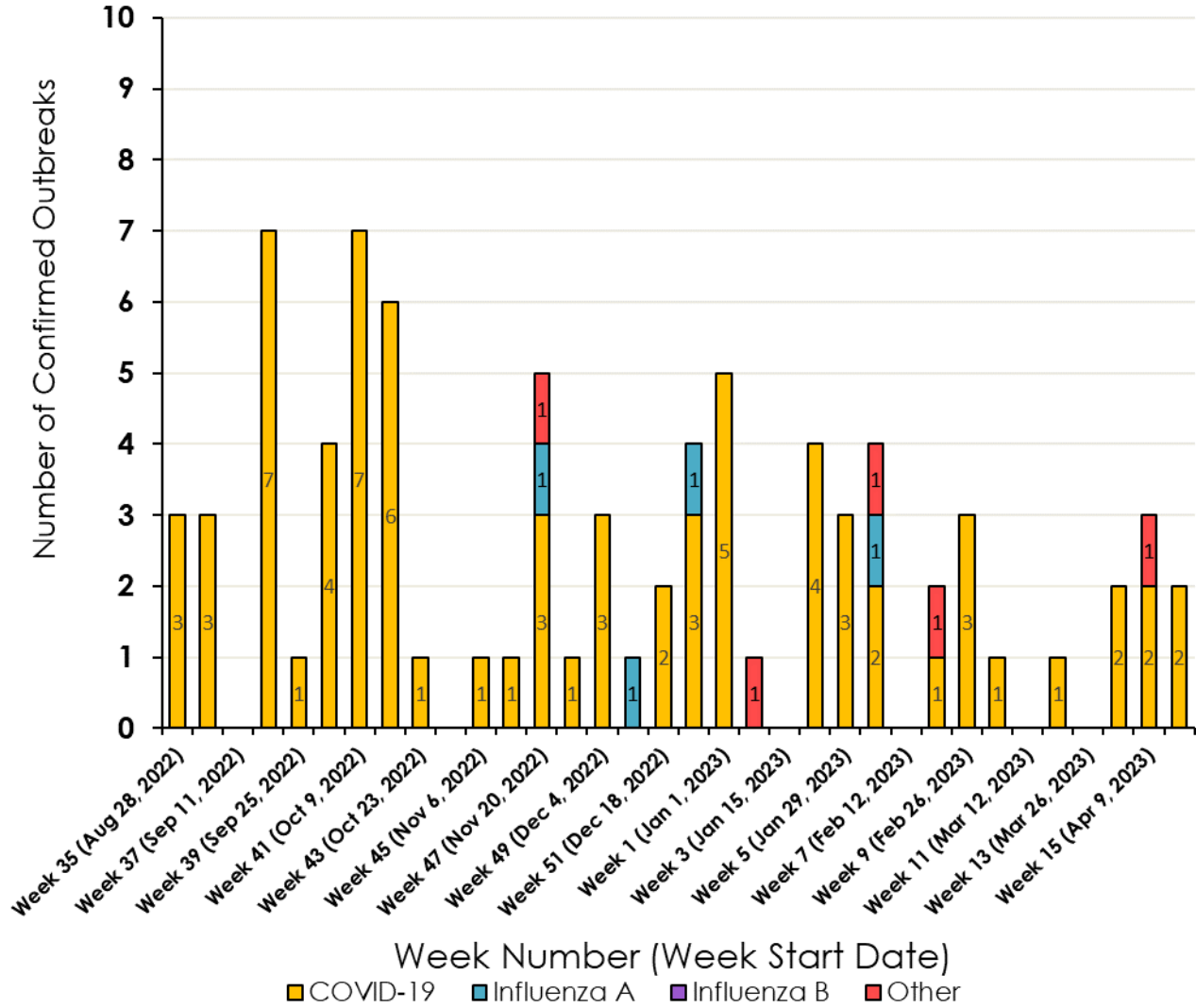
