Indicator	Week 11 in RCD	Compared to Week 10
Laboratory-Confirmed Influenza Cases	18 cases in Week 11 compared to 6 cases in Week 10	Higher
ED Visits for Influenza-Like-Illness (ILI) and Respiratory Concerns	Visits for influenza-like illness and respiratory concerns accounted for 16.1% of ED visits in Week 11 compared to 14.1% in Week 10. (Source: Acute Care Enhanced Surveillance (ACES), 2023)	Higher

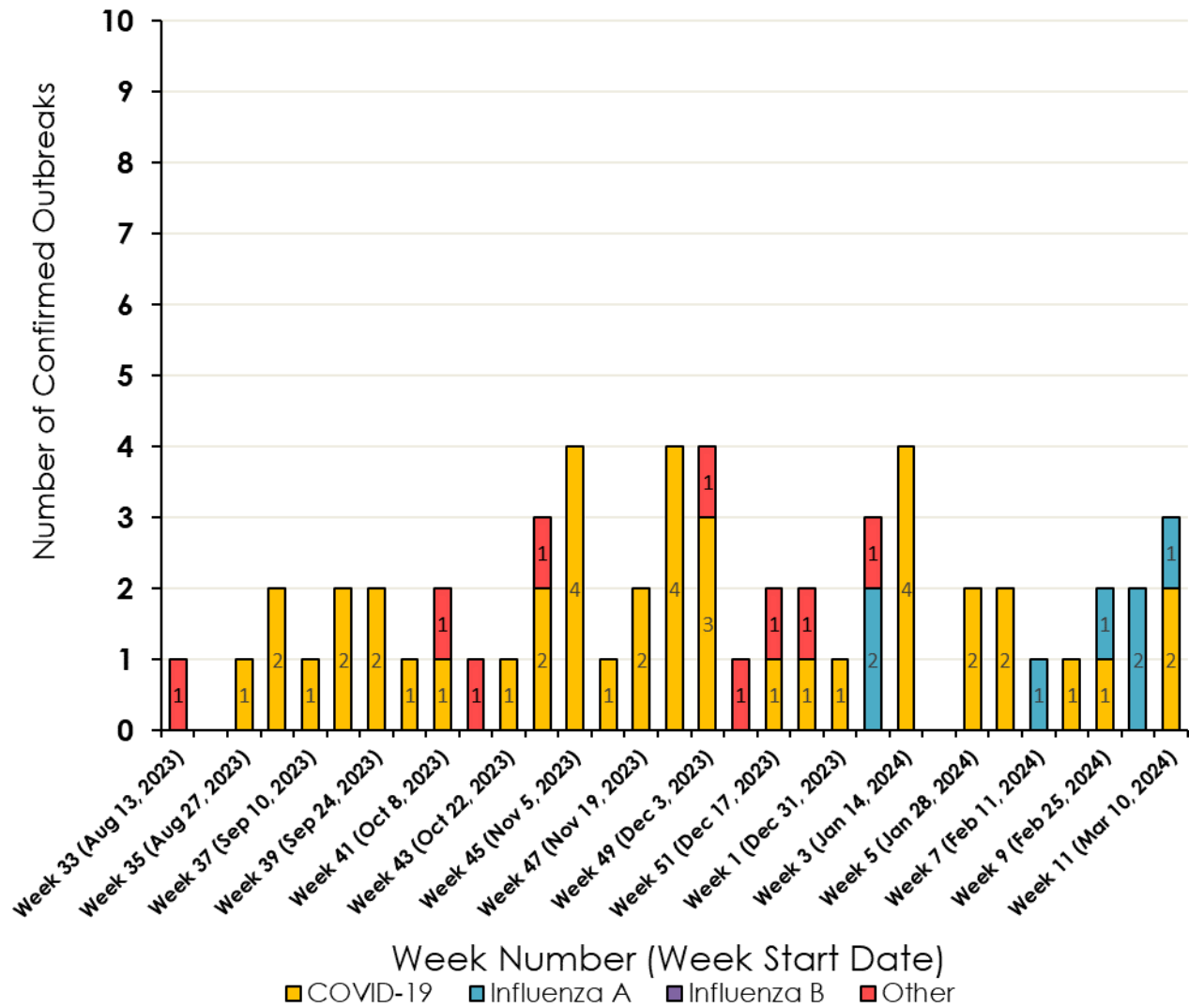
